

What kind of shelf do I have?

Determining the manufacturer of your fixtures can be like solving a puzzle with many pieces. You should check the most obvious first:

☐ Are any of the components stamped with a manufacturer name or part number?
☐ Do you have any original paperwork which might provide clues to the brand?
☐ If you bought used fixtures, do you know from which retailer you purchased?
Specs and dimensions:
☐ What is the on-center slotting measurement of the standard?
☐ Are the end standards single-slotted or double-slotted?
☐ What is the usable space dimension of your shelves or deck?
☐ Do the decks and shelves have round or diamond shaped perfs?
Take photos of the entire fixture from the front and side. Include close-up photos of the following features:
☐ Standard slotting (with a tape measure alongside it to show scale)
☐ Shelf brackets (where they insert into the standard)
☐ Base brackets (the piece that inserts into the standard and supports the deck).
